Authors working in various sectors are welcomed to submit any pieces on relevant issues which concern the intersections between sport and human rights. Each piece will be reviewed for publication. Submissions should be sent by email to contact@presful.org as a Word document.

1. Types of articles

| Structure | Pieces of no less than 600 words and no more than 1500 words, excluding footnotes, references and appendices. | Pieces of no less than 800 words and no more than 2000 words, excluding footnotes, references and appendices. | Pieces of no less than 800 words and no more than 2000 words, excluding footnotes, references and appendices. |

2. Style guide

- 12 pt. Times New Roman font.
- Please provide author's name, contact and a short biographical note.
- Title needs to be under 20 words and Bold.
- For the use of (digital) references, try to stick to APA 7.
- Use of copyright free pictures.
- Please check the attached template for further clarifications.

| Structure | Details |

| Author's name | Please provide the author's full name |
| Author's contact | Please provide the author's contact details and information on the affiliated institution/ working sector. |
| Biographical note | Outline the author's interests, field of expertise and any relevant information the author would like to share (50 words max). |
| Introduction | Outline the topic of interest and provide the readers with some background knowledge necessary to understand the pieces' content. |
| Paragraphs | Provide argumentations, analysis, evaluations, along with positive/negative examples. As for transcribed interviews, please make sure to clearly distinguish between questions and answers, and to provide detailed information on the interviewee and his/her field of expertise. It is important to divide the argumentations into paragraphs, utilising a clear narrative and well-researched information. |
| Conclusion | Present recommendations or concluding remarks. |
| References | Please try to stick to APA 7. Further examples and guidelines can be found at this link: https://libguides.csudh.edu/ |
